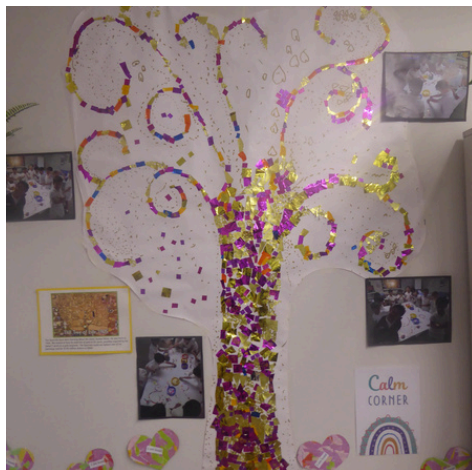

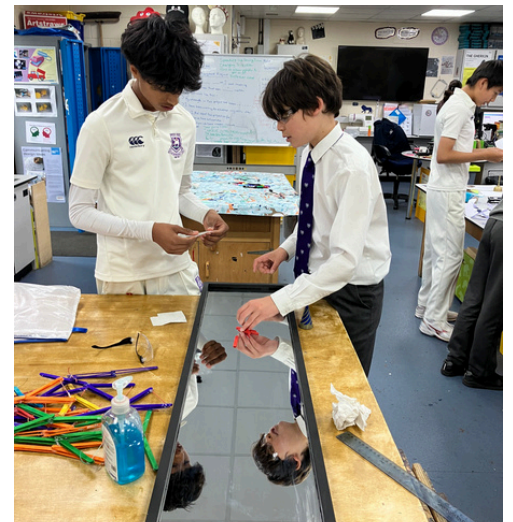
Plenty of artistic energy in the Art Room
