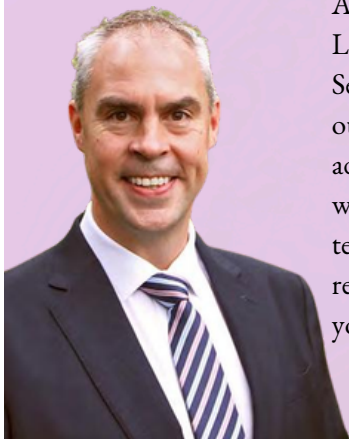




# What a wonderful year!

# Junior Prize-Giving

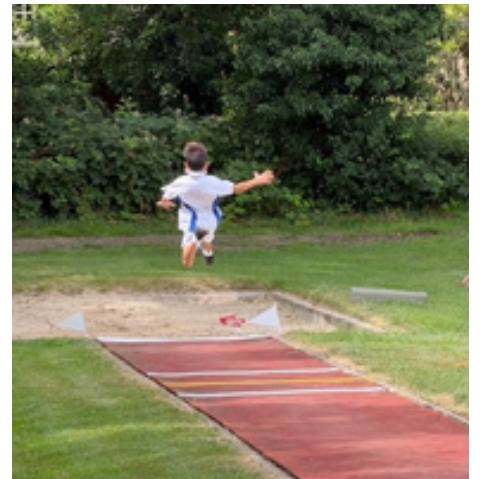
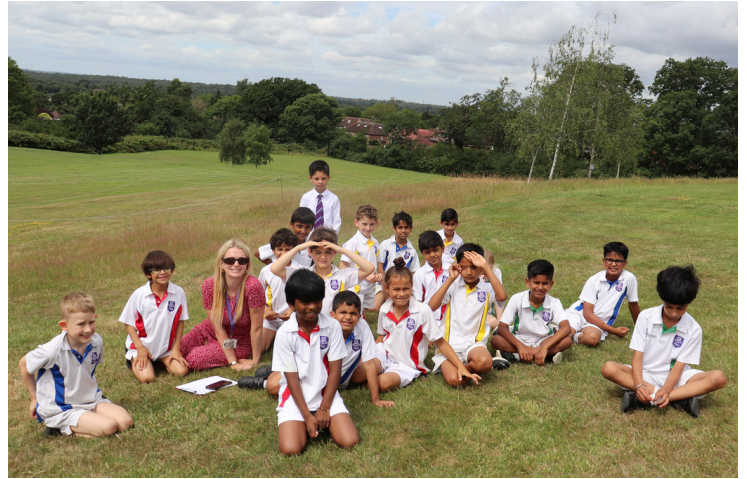
